Materials for Colored Pencil Workshop with Kendra Ferreira

- <u>Set of at least 48 colored pencils</u> I recommend Prismacolor (called Soft Core or Premier) as they are the easiest to work with. However, larger sets of pencils are better for a good variety of color. Students may choose to bring another brand especially if they already own pencils.
- Small sketch pad for thumbnails or trying out colors. Doesn't have to be new, can be something students already own.
- White drawing paper such a Legion Stonehenge, Strathmore Drawing Paper (300, 400 or 500 series), any brand Bristol Vellum Surface. Can be individual sheets or pad, we won't work larger than 11x14"
- Standard lead pencil
- Kneaded eraser (gray) and any other eraser you would like
- Pencil sharpener; handheld or battery operated
- Masonite backing board as a work surface
