# Watercolor Materials

(Links are only suggestions. No need to buy all new supplies, bring what you have.)

### **Watercolor Paints**

Any brand is ok, but I use <u>Winsor Newton</u>. They make this less expensive <u>Cotman set</u> which is ok for beginners.

I suggest tubes of paint rather than pans or half pans.

Suggested colors:

- Cobalt Blue
- French Ultramarine Blue
- Antwerp blue or Prussian Blue
- Winsor Yellow or Cadmium Yellow Light
- Raw Sienna (Winsor Newton brand only) or Yellow Ochre
- Brown Madder and/or Burnt Sienna
- Burnt Umber
- Rose Madder or Alizarin Crimson
- White Gouache\* (Nice to have for finishing touches.)
- Dioxazine Purple
- Winsor Red or Cadmium Red
- Cobalt Turquoise
- Perylene Green

If you already have watercolors, you don't need to buy all new tubes. Just make sure you have a variety of warm and cool blues, yellows, and reds, as well as some neutral browns.

# Watercolor Paper

If you are going to splurge on anything, *I think paper is the most important*. Any brand is ok, but paper should be Cold Press or Rough, and 140 lb or 300 lb. (NOT Hot Press and NOT 90 lb.) I use <u>Arches rough 300 lb</u>. which I buy in large sheets and rip to size, but it is very expensive. You can also <u>buy blocks</u> of paper, 9"x12" or 10"x14" is recommended.

#### Watercolor Brushes

Any brand is fine. Just make sure they are watercolor brushes. I recommend *various sizes of round brushes*. Also: a rigger\*, and wash\* or mop\* watercolor brush might be nice. A good sample starter <u>set</u> from KingArt.

## Watercolor Palette

Any watercolor palette is ok. Here is <u>a travel palette</u>, or a <u>full size option</u>. You can even use a plain white butcher tray or porcelain platter.

#### Other

- Paper towels or tissues, and a container for water (I use an old yogurt container)
- Small spray bottle
- <u>Sketchbook</u>\* (<u>watercolor paper</u> is nice, but not necessary)
- White Artist tape\* (only necessary to tape paper to board if not using a block)
- Board\* (to tape loose paper, i.e. masonite, foam core, drawing board, thick cardboard)
- Kitchen sponge\*
- Mr. Clean Magic Eraser\*
